

**Earn an Accredited Theological Degree:
The Anglican School of Ministry-Little Rock Can Help**

The Anglican School of Ministry-Little Rock is recognized by the Anglican Mission in the Americas as structured program for reading for orders. The School is not accredited by a CHEA or USDE-recognized agency. However, it has an articulation agreement with the accredited South African Theological Seminary for admission of ASM-LR students into the seminary's Master of Theology program. Students may enroll in either the thesis-only program (requires a 150-page thesis) or the structured program (requires a shorter thesis plus additional research papers)

Dr. Kevin Smith, Vice Principal of South African Theological Seminary (SATS), agreed to accept students with a non-theological, accredited bachelor's degree and an ASM-LR diploma into SATS. Additionally, Dr. Smith has stated that students with an ASM-LR Diploma who do not have a bachelor's degree may receive advanced standing toward SATS's Bachelor of Theology degree.

Concerning the Diploma program, Dr. Smith said, "... the work your students are doing looks quite comprehensive and appears to be at a good level... This is a substantial amount of work. I have no reservations confirming that we would accept anyone with an accredited Bachelor's (non-theological) plus the ASM-LR Diploma in Pastoral Theology directly into our MTh."
